REMO PROJECT

The aim of the REMO project is to foster regional exchange and improve the quality of working mobility. Therefore, an online platform and a network will be developed which allows everyone who is involved into vocational education and training (VET) to get informed, inform and connect/interact with each other for planning and implementation of mobility actions (learning and working mobility). For learners, VET organisations and the world of work the platform will allow online planning, organisation and implementation of VET mobility.

Within the REMO project ISO 9001 coherent quality process descriptions developed will form the core document for quality implementation of initial VET mobility.

INTRODUCTORY RESEARCH

Right now we are in the first working phase, implementing an introductory research throughout Europe in all partner countries. Data about experiences and needs of the broad REMO target group get collected threw questionnaires and interviews in favor of having an attractive, easy manageable, effective but as well broad basis for the development of the REMO online platform and network.

FIRST PROJECT MEETINGS

The kick-off meeting of the REMO project was held in Kranj, Slovenia from the 4th until the 5th of November 2014. As it was not possible to find a date within the first project months for the entire consortium, a second part of the kick-off meeting took place two weeks later in Graz, Austria from the 18th until the 19th of November. Thereby it was possible for all partners to have the chance for a common start into the first working phase.

Once the current phase of data collection has been completed the results will be available on the website. After that, work on ISO 9001 coherent quality process descriptions will start.
